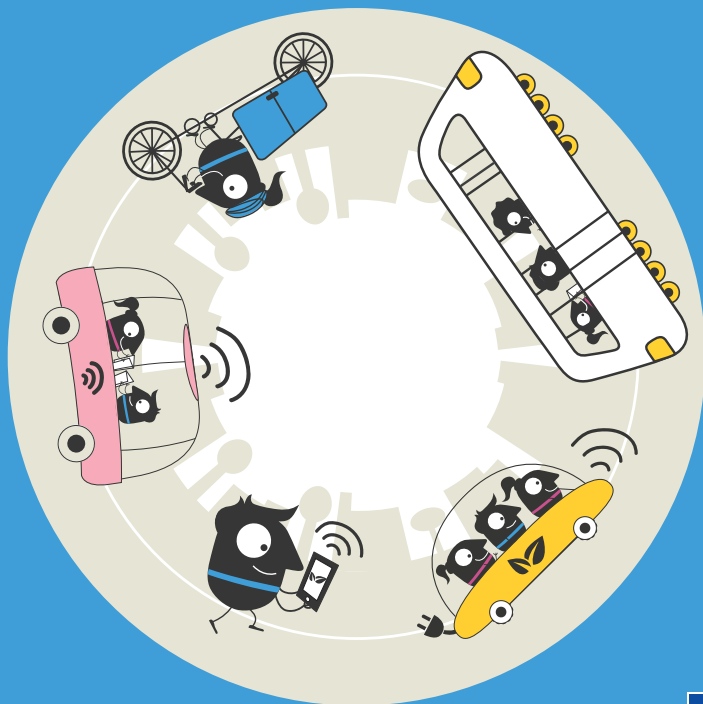

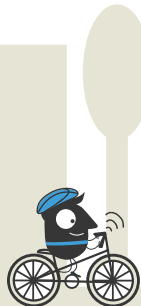


# About EUROPEANMOBILITYWEEK

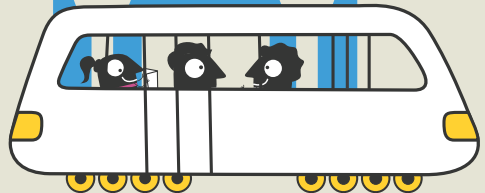
